## Assertion + tag:

You were in the cathedral, weren't you? -Yes, I was.

## Negation + tag

She  $\underline{\text{was}} \mathbf{n't}$  afraid,  $\underline{\text{was}}$  she ? -No, she  $\underline{\text{was}} \mathbf{n't}$
