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- W questions

What has he got... ? Why have they got... ?

How have you got... ?

- Assertion+tag/ negation+tag

He's got a mask, hasn't he ? He hasn't got a mask, has he ?
They've got blue costumes, haven't they ? They haven't got blue costumes, have they ?
